Thank you for the recent documentation and my inclusion in the Trafford Core Strategy consultation process.

I recall the arguments debated at length that took Davenport Green out of Green Belt to enable business development opportunities to be implemented. At a later date the routing of the proposed metro link was also to run through Davenport Green. Neither of these have happened and some 20 plus years on the land in question has benefited from nature running its course.

On a recent inspection I was delighted to be able to wander through a very pleasant country area with large areas of meadow flowers and self-seeded shrubs and trees supporting a range of birds and animals. From the well walked paths through Davenport Green it is clear that the area now forms a significant recreational parkland, a vital pair of lungs serving a large residential area and providing a buffer from a motorway and the noise of the airport in the back ground.

My view is that the Core Strategy should not be changes and that the land at Davenport Green should be put into the Green Belt and protected for the use of residents and for the protection of the local environment.
