When adopted, the Land Allocations DPD will set out new site allocations for housing, employment and other purposes and identify areas to be safeguarded from development for environmental or other reasons. Area covered: The Plan will cover the whole of the Trafford borough except for Altrincham Town Centre. These allocations will be included in the proposed Altrincham Town Centre Business Neighbourhood Plan being produced by Altrincham Forward.
