It was agreed at the Parish Council meeting on 3rd November 2020 that Warburton Parish Council should apply for a precept in the next financial year. The Parish Council is very aware of the financial climate and have limited their request to Trafford accordingly. They hope that a precept set at £50 per household in Band D will be acceptable.

The money raised would be used towards:-

- The stone cross base is suffering badly from subsidence and is in urgent need of repair. Although we hope to get grants it won't cover the whole cost.
- There are costs relating to expenses incurred when preparing our Neighbourhood Plan. Again, there are grants available, but these will probably not cover the whole cost.
- If the Redrow appeal goes to a second hearing further professional fees will be required.
- The proposed defibrillator is still under review.
- The purchase of a speed monitor is being considered as an aid to reduce speeding throughout the parish.

The amounts to be set for each property band are:

Band A, being 6/9 of Band D	= £33.33
Band B, being 7/9 of Band D	= £38.89
Band C, being 8/9 of Band D	= £44.44
Band D, being 9/9 of Band D	= £50.00
Band E, being 11/9 of Band D	= £61.11
Band F, being 13/9 of Band D	= £72.22
Band G, being 15/9 of Band D	= £83.33
Band H, being 18/9 of Band D	= £100.00
