| Universal | Up to 15 hours per week of early education for all children from the term after their 3rd <br> birthday. There is no universal funding for younger children. |
| Working Parent Entitlement | Up to 15 hours per week of early education for eligible children the term after they turn 9 <br> months. Families apply to HMRC (via the Childcare Choices webpage) for an eligibility code. This <br> funding increases to 30 hours per week from September 25 for 2 years old and under. |
| Disadvantaged Entitlement | Up to 15 hours per week of early education for eligible 2 year olds, where the family is receiving <br> additional support. |
