

KINGSWAY, STRETTFORD PROJECT UPDATE

Further to previous notices, the works to Kingsway is now underway. As part of the improvements, Trafford Council is looking to make the Kingsway and Barton Road junction safer and greener as part of its transformation of the town. Plans include new crossing points, cycle lanes, footpaths, trees and green spaces. The Kingsway carriageway is also being re-designed to help reduce speeds and improve space for cyclists and pedestrians.

Traffic management will increase from the 5th June with the partial closure of Kingsway Westbound however, one lane will remain open for the duration of the works. To facilitate this lane closure safely, Edge Lane approaching Kingsway will have one lane closed at the junction with the A56.

The timing of the traffic signals have been changed since the works started, and we will continue to make changes as necessary to mitigate excessive delays. We appreciate these works are disruptive and hope that you will start to see the improvements take shape over the coming months.

Buses will also continue to follow these diversions with the existing stops of Edge Lane, Urmston Lane and the A56 remaining in place and these will serve the 2 existing stops on Kingsway that will be closed for the duration of the works.

Please note that these works are being managed by Trafford Council and not Bruntwood or Stretford Mall.
