LEVEL 1 INTRODUCTION TO CHILDCARE SWAP

This level 1 Childcare course aims to give learners a clear insight into career development within a childcare setting. Multiple subject areas are covered, and by the end of the course, learners will be able to:

- > Know the range of settings in early years provision.
- > Understand the key services offered in the different types of settings.
- > Know the roles, responsibilities, and possible career routes in early years settings.
- > Understand the core skills required for work in early years settings and plan for a career.

During the course, learners will examine the key stages in a child's development, look at factors that might affect the behaviour of young children and identify ways to support the social, emotional, and psychological needs of young children.
