not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may under paragraph 12 of Schedule 15 to the 1981 Act, within 6 weeks from 18th January 2024 make application

The whole length of a footpath to be upgraded to a bridleway on the Definitive Map commencing on Sinderland Lane at grid reference SJ 74851 90278 (point "A" on the

Order Map) then running for the whole length of the footpath in a northerly direction to grid reference SJ 74834 90468 (point "D" on the Order Map) to join the southern end

of Restricted Byway no 9, Altrincham where the way terminates. The way is shown by a continuous line with cross bars at intervals on the Order Map.

Width: 3.5 metres with local widening at grid reference

SJ 74847, 90368 (point "B" on the Order Map) to 6.0 metres and with local widening at grid reference SJ 74843 90398
