

**THE TRANSPORT FOR GREATER MANCHESTER (LIGHT RAPID TRANSIT SYSTEM)
(TRAFFORD PARK EXTENSION) ORDER 2016**

**BOROUGH OF TRAFFORD (WARREN BRUCE ROAD, ELEVATOR ROAD AND
WATERSIDE, TRAFFORD PARK)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 2017 – Ref TPL 0015**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that pursuant to the provisions of Article 42 of The Transport for Greater Manchester (Light Rapid Transit System) (Trafford Park Extension) Order 2016, Transport for Greater Manchester (TfGM) intends to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order, the effect of which will be to prohibit driving, except for emergency service vehicles (in the case of an emergency), vehicle being used for the purposes of constructing the Trafford Park Metrolink Extension and for statutory undertakers in pursuance of statutory powers as follows:-

Prohibition of Driving

Road Name	Length Affected
Warren Bruce Road, Trafford Park	From its junction with Trafford Wharf Road for a distance of 60 metres south of that junction
Elevator Road, Trafford Park	From its junction with Trafford Wharf Road for a distance of 30 metres south of that junction
Waterside, Trafford Park	From its junction with Trafford Wharf Road for a distance of 60 metres south of that junction

The reason for the Order is to facilitate statutory utility diversion works and the construction of the Trafford Park Metrolink Extension.

The alternative route for vehicles using these roads to access Trafford Wharf Road from the south will be via Wharfside Way, Village Circle, Trafford Park Road, Churchill Way and Trafford Wharf Road.

The alternative route for vehicles accessing any of these roads from Trafford Wharf Road will be:-

- for Waterside via Sir Alex Ferguson Way;
- for Elevator Road via Trafford Road, White City Roundabout, Wharfside Way (westbound), Village Circle and Wharfside Way (eastbound);
- for Warren Bruce Road via Trafford Road, White City Roundabout, Wharfside Way (westbound) and Village Circle.

It is anticipated that Warren Bruce Road and Elevator Road will not be closed at the same time. When one is closed the other will remain open to facilitate local access on to Trafford Wharf Road. Local diversion signing will be placed on site to identify these routes.

The Order came into operation on 19th June 2017 and is expected to be in force intermittently for a period of 3 years.

The effects of this Order in relation to Elevator Road will be in force from the 15th July for a period of approximately 6 months.
