

**THE TRANSPORT FOR GREATER MANCHESTER (LIGHT RAPID TRANSIT SYSTEM)
(TRAFFORD PARK EXTENSION) ORDER 2016**

**BOROUGH OF TRAFFORD (VILLAGE WAY, EUROPA WAY, TRAFFORD PARK)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING AND ONE WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 2019 – Ref
TPL 108**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that pursuant to the provisions of Article 42 of The Transport for Greater Manchester (Light Rapid Transit System) (Trafford Park Extension) Order 2016, Transport for Greater Manchester (TfGM) intends to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order, the effect of which will be to:

- Prohibit driving between the hours of 11pm and 6am as shown in schedule 1 below; and
- Introduce one-way traffic between the hours of 8pm and 6am as shown in schedule 2 below.

Driving is prohibited, except for emergency service vehicles (in the case of an emergency), vehicles being used for the purposes of constructing the Trafford Park Metrolink Extension and for statutory undertakers in pursuance of statutory powers as follows:-

SCHEDULE 1 - Prohibition of Driving (operative 11pm to 6am on Mondays to Fridays)

Road Name	Length Affected
Village Way (eastbound carriageway), Trafford Park	The eastbound carriageway between its junctions with Fifth Avenue and Village Circle

SCHEDULE 2 – One-way traffic (operative 8pm to 6am on Mondays to Fridays)

Column 1 Road name and length	Column 2 Direction of travel
Europa Way, Trafford Park from its junction with Europa Circle to its junction with Village Circle a distance of approximately 445 metres	From its junction with Village Circle to its junction with Europa Circle, southbound

The reason for the Order is to facilitate carriageway surfacing works associated with the Trafford Park Metrolink Extension works.

It should be noted that the restrictions above will not be in operation at the same time. Whilst Schedule 1 is in operation Schedule 2 will not be and vice versa. This is to facilitate local access and diversion routes. Local diversion signing will be placed on site to identify these routes.

For the period when Village Way is closed, the alternative route for Eastbound traffic will be Fifth Avenue, Westinghouse Road, Europa Circle, Europa Way, Village Circle. Village Way is currently closed to Westbound traffic and so the diversion currently in operation (Village Circle, Europa Way, Europa Circle, Westinghouse Road, Parkway Circle) remains.

For the period when Europa Way is operating one way to southbound traffic, the alternative route for Northbound traffic will be Europa Circle, Westinghouse Road, Fifth Avenue, Village Way.

The Order will come into operation on 27th May 2019 and is expected to remain in force for a period of 2 weeks.
