### THE TRAFFORD (LOCK LANE BAILEY LANE, PARTINGTON) (CONSTRUCTION OF ROAD HUMPS) NOTICE 2019

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that under powers confirmed by Section 62(3), 90(A) – (F) of the Highway Act 1980, as amended by the Transport Act 1981, Trafford Council proposes the construction and removal of road humps on a road in Partington, in accordance with the Highways (Road Humps) Regulations 1999.

The effect of the proposal will be to remove the existing road humps, detailed below, and replace them with a speed table at the junction of Lock Lane, Bailey Lane and Birchwood Drive as follows

#### SCHEDULE 1 – PROPOSED

75mm Speed Table

Lock Lane

- at the junction with Bailey Lane and Birchwood Drive

#### SCHEDULE 2 – REMOVALS

75mm Round Top Road Humps

Lock Lane

- Approximately 22 metres west of its junction with Bailey Lane.
- Approximately 29 metres east of its junction with Bailey Lane.

## **STATEMENT OF REASONS**

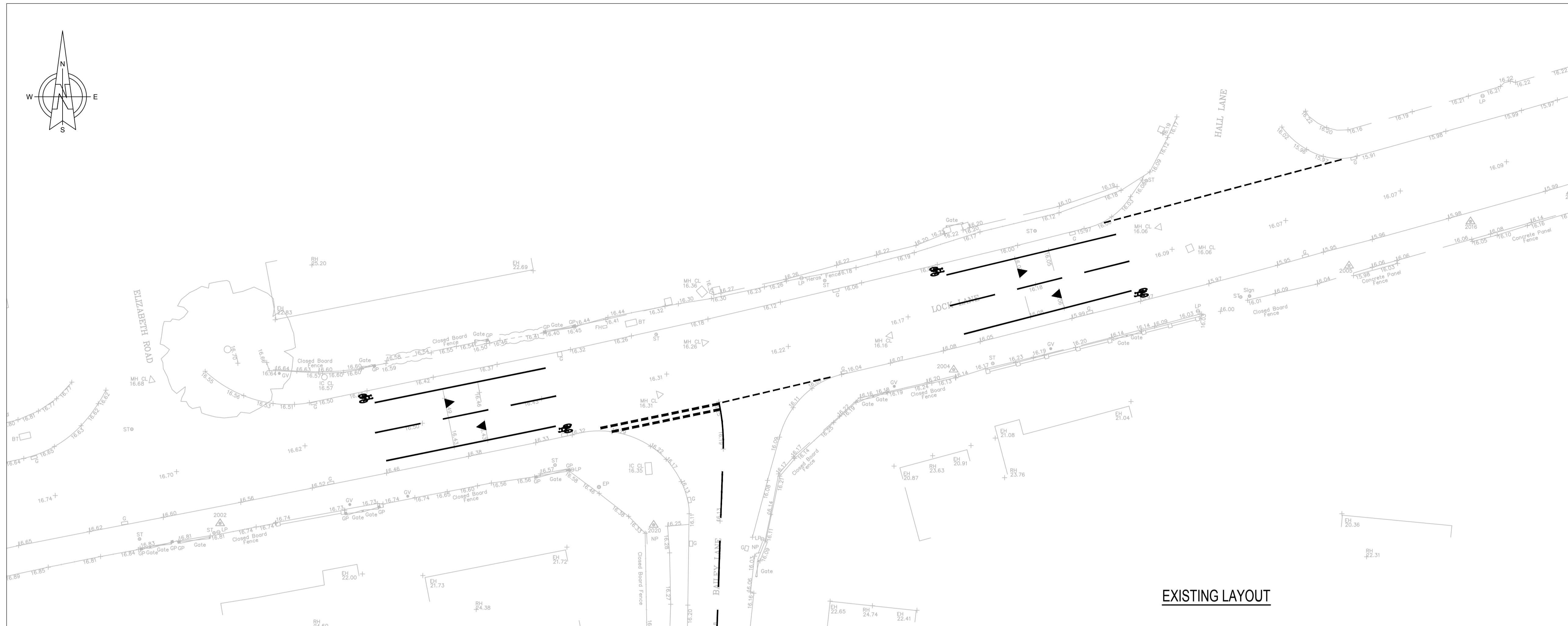
In June 2017 Trafford Council approved a planning application at 4, Lock Lane Partington to demolish the existing dwelling and erect 22 no new dwellings. A condition of the approved planning consent requires a raised traffic table to be provided at the junction of Lock Lane, Bailey Lane and the new residential road named Birchwood Close.

It is therefore proposed to amend Road Humps on the above-named roads to control speeds and traffic movements at the junction.  
It is proposed to introduce the scheme as soon as is practicable.

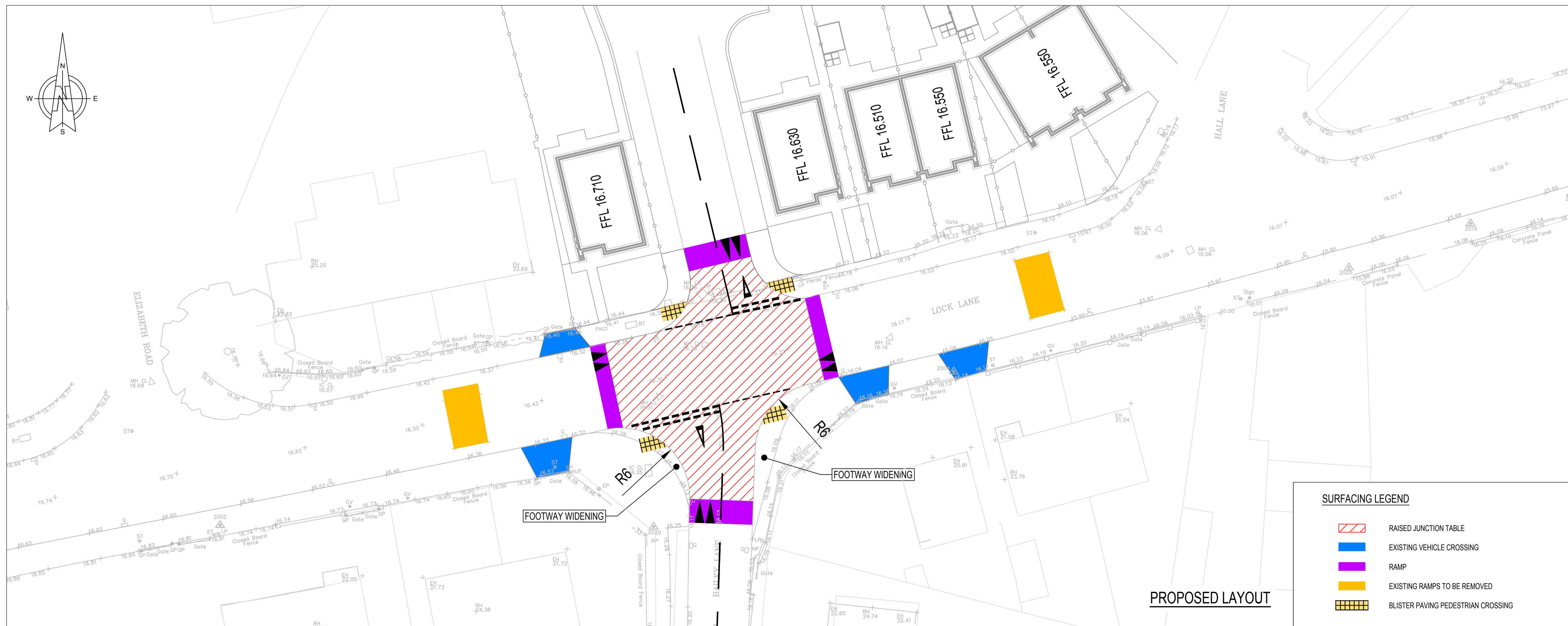







EXISTING LAYOUT
