The road humps, which will reduce vehicle speeds, will be 75 mm high speed cushions and will be placed in the vicinity of the following locations:-

SCHEDULE

Glebelands Road, Sale - 75mm Speed Cushions

Approximately 34 metres west of its junction with Carlton Road. Approximately 50 metres northwest of its junction with Grosvenor Road. Approximately 13 metres southeast of its junction with Little Ees Lane. Approximately 70 metres west of its junction with Little Ees Lane.

THE TRAFFORD (GLEBELANDS ROAD, SALE) (CONSTRUCTION OF ROAD HUMPS) NOTICE 2024

The Borough of Trafford, under powers confirmed by Section 62(3), 90(A), (B), (C), (D) and (F) of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, proposes to construct road humps on Glebelands Road, Sale in accordance with the Highways (Road Humps) Regulations1999.

The 75 mm high speed cushions will be placed on either side of the Glebelands Road/Grosvenor Road junction and will reduce vehicle speeds.

STATEMENT OF REASON

The Council has been contacted by residents to address issues of road safety on Glebelands Road, Sale in particular the section between Dumber Lane and Park Road. A section of Glebelands Road was partially traffic calmed around 2003, as part of a local safety scheme and the features ended at that time around its junction with Park Road. In more recent years numerous complaints have been received about the inappropriate speed of vehicles travelling along the section that has no traffic calming. There are concerns relating to collisions occurring at the bend near the junction of Grosvenor Road and along the section adjacent to Ashton Park.

The Council previously proposed to install a mini roundabout located at the junction of Grosvenor Road and Glebelands Road, to help improve pedestrian safety and to reduce vehicle speeds around the bend however having reassessed the circumstances, it is proposed to introduce additional traffic calming measures in the form of 'speed cushions' on Glebelands to improve pedestrian access and road safety for all road users
