

BOROUGH OF TRAFFORD (GORSEY LANE, ALTRINCHAM) (ONE-WAY TRAFFIC AND MANDATORY CONTRAFLOW 24 HOUR CYCLE LANE) EXPERIMENTAL ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Trafford Borough Council has made the above-named Order under Sections (1), (2) and (9) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Order will be to impose one-way traffic flow, on all vehicles except for cycles in a mandatory contraflow cycle lane, for an experimental period of 18 months, as follows:-

Schedule 1

One Way Traffic

Gorsey Lane, Altrincham

From - a point 15 metres north of its junction with Dunham Road

To - its junction with Dunham Road, **in that direction**

Schedule 2

Mandatory Contraflow 24 Hour Cycle Lane

Gorsey Lane, Altrincham - west side - for a 1.5 metre width

From - its junction with Dunham Road

To - a point 15 metres north of its junction with Dunham Road, **in that direction**

The Experimental Order will come into operation on 15th January 2024, for a period of 18 months and a copy, together with a map, showing the lengths of road, to which it relates, may be inspected at Altrincham Library during its normal opening hours. The Council will be considering, in due course, whether the provisions of the Order should be continued in force indefinitely.

Within a period of 6 months from the coming into force of the Order, or if the Order is subsequently modified or varied, from the coming into operation of that modification or the variation (whichever is the latest), any person may object to the making of the Order for the purposes of such indefinite continuation.

SATEMENT OF REASONS

A segregated SPARROW crossing, for pedestrians and cyclists, has been constructed on Dunham Road, Altrincham at its junction with Gorsey Lane.

Gorsey Lane is being made one-way for a length of 15 metres from its junction with Dunham Road, which will allow vehicles to travel southwards towards Dunham Road whilst allowing cyclists travel in both directions, thus making full use of the new crossing facility.

BOROUGH OF TRAFFORD (GORSEY LANE, ALTRINCHAM) (ONE-WAY TRAFFIC AND MANDATORY CONTRAFLOW 24 HOUR CYCLE LANE) EXPERIMENTAL ORDER 2024

Trafford Borough Council, in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 9(1) to (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police, in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order for a period of 18 months:-

1. No person shall, except upon the direction of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order, other than in the direction specified in the Schedule
2. No person shall, except upon the direction of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle, other than a pedal cycle travelling from Dunham Road to Gorsey Lane to enter, proceed, or wait in the length of cycle lane specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
3. This Order shall come into operation on 15th January 2024 and may be cited as the Borough of Trafford (Gorsey Lane, Altrincham)(One-Way Traffic and Mandatory Contraflow 24 Hour Cycle Lane) Experimental Order 2024.

Gorsey Lane, Altrincham west side for a 1.5 metre width

From - its junction with Dunham Road

To - a point 15 metres north of its junction with Dunham Road, **in that direction**

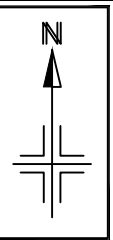

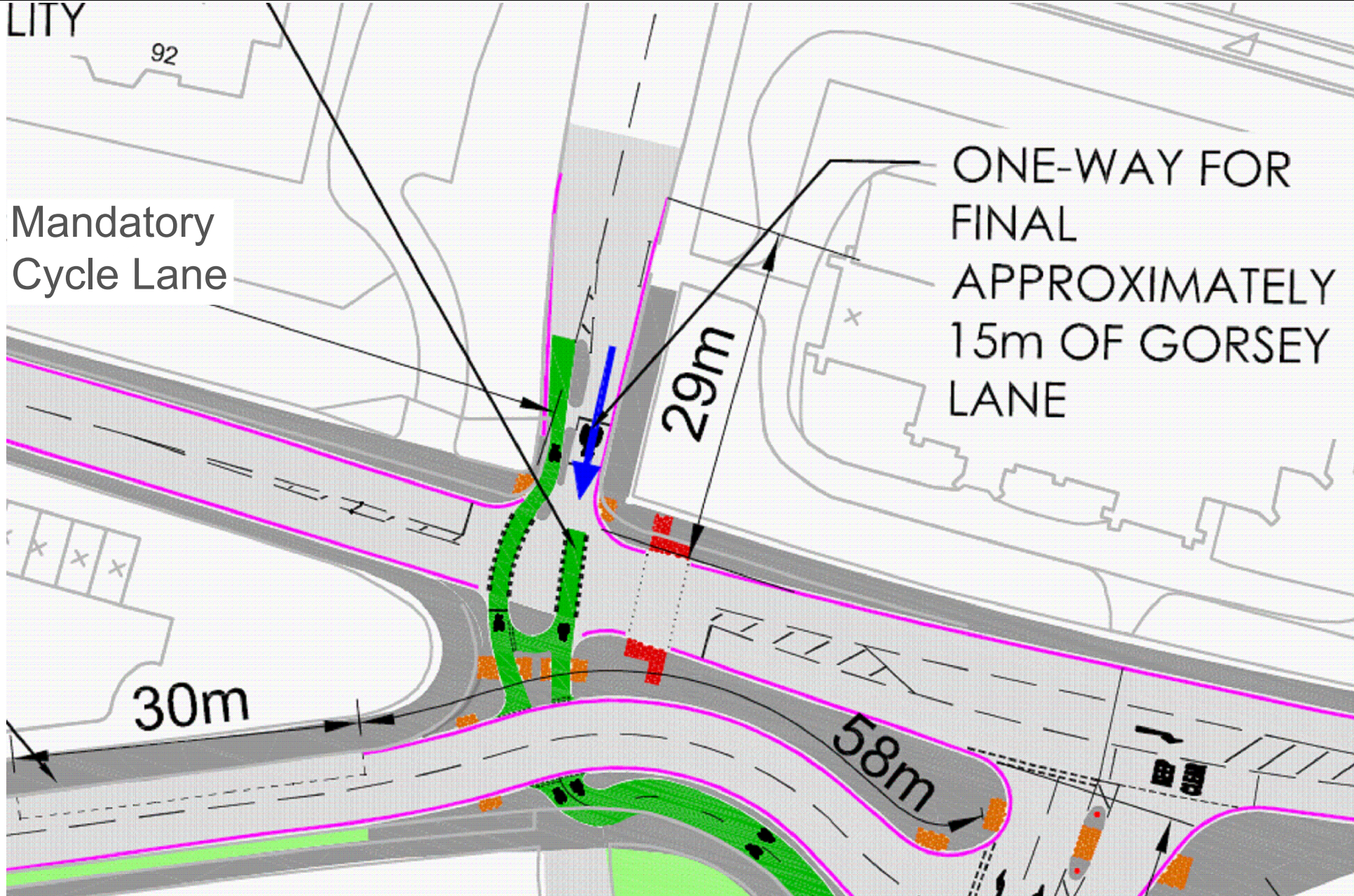
