

**BOROUGH OF TRAFFORD (PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PROVISION OF PARKING) ORDER 2001 (AMENDMENT NO 164)(PART A) ORDER 2014**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Trafford Borough Council has made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order will be to amend the Borough of Trafford (Prohibition of Waiting and Loading and Provision of Parking) Order 2001, as amended, (“the 2001 Order”) by the introduction of the following provisions:

- a) No Waiting at Any Time No Loading At Any Time Code - 7A7A
- b) Waiting Limited to 10 mins No Return Within 1 Hour, At Any Time Code - LU7A

on the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1 hereto by the addition, to the Schedule to the 2001 Order, of the length of road specified in Schedule 1 below.

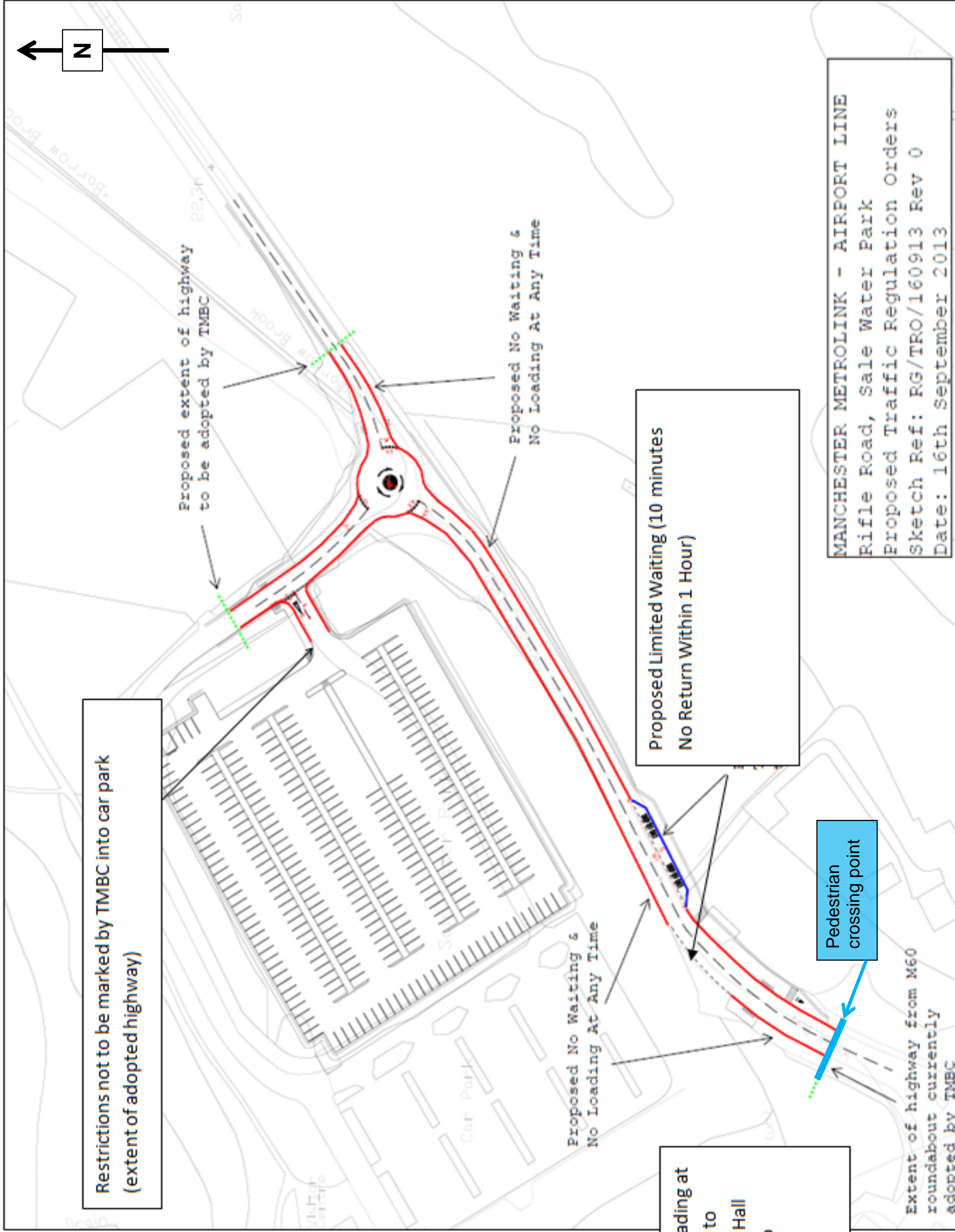


Figure 1 - Drawing E8908 – Proposed parking & waiting restrictions
