The table below comprises Trafford Council's Draft Regulation 123 list. It indicates the infrastructure that the Council currently considers it is likely to apply CIL monies towards.

Infrastructure currently considered likely to benefit from the application of CIL funding:
Strategic transport infrastructure including: <i>Western Gateway Infrastructure Scheme (WGIS)</i> <i>Extension of Metrolink through Trafford Park</i> <i>New Link Road to and through the development site at Carrington</i> <i>Significant improvements to public transport in Carrington and Partington</i> <i>Transformational junction improvement scheme in Stretford</i>
Strategic flood risk and drainage projects <i>Including those identified in the Local Flood Risk Management Strategy</i>
School facilities including: <i>Borough-wide expansion of primary schools to provide additional intake places</i> <i>Provision of a 1-form entry primary school to serve Pomona Island, Trafford Wharfside, Old Trafford and Lancashire County Cricket Club Quarter</i> <i>Provision of a 2-form entry primary school in Carrington</i> <i>Provision of a 1-form entry primary school in Altrincham</i> <i>Provision of a 1-form entry primary school in Stretford</i> <i>Borough-wide expansion of secondary schools to provide additional intake places</i>
Strategic sport and recreational facilities including: <i>Provision of a major wet and dry facility at Stretford</i> <i>Provision of a major wet and dry facility at Sale/Altrincham</i>
Strategic green infrastructure <i>Apart from those projects delivered directly on-site (including those for residential developments of 300 units or more)</i>
