Dear Sir,-

I herewith enclose you a sample of the felt we intend to use on the new rink; it is of exactly similar quality to that used by us on a flat roof last year. This roof holds at least 2" of water, and is spot dry. The specification calls for a drop dry job for 10 years, and the felt to be capable of withstanding tensile strain for 600 lbs: per square foot.
