#### **Adoption Statement**

In accordance with Regulation 14 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2012, notice is hereby given that the above-mentioned SPD was adopted by Trafford Council’s Executive on 27 October 2014 (modified on 15<sup>th</sup> December).

The SPD set out the boundaries of the Conservation Areas, enabling the Council to manage change in these historic areas in a way that will conserve and enhance them. The appraisals contain a wealth of information about the town’s heritage assets, including identifying landmark buildings and other buildings which contribute positively to the conservation area.

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of that decision. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than three months from the 15<sup>th</sup> December 2014.
