Adoption Statement

In accordance with Regulation 14 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2012, notice is hereby given that the above-mentioned SPD was adopted by Trafford Council’s Executive on 21 March 2016.

The Conservation Area Appraisal (SPD 5.7) sets out the boundaries of the Conservation Area, enabling the Council to manage change in this historic area in a way that will conserve and enhance it. The appraisal contains a wealth of information about the areas heritage assets, including identifying landmark buildings and other buildings which contribute positively to the conservation area. The Conservation Area Management Plan (SPD 5.7a) provides further detail on architectural style, building materials, boundary treatments and rear extensions and details of the public realm and streetscape. Policies then set out parameters to manage future change to the Conservation Area.

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of that decision. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than three months from the 21 March 2016.
