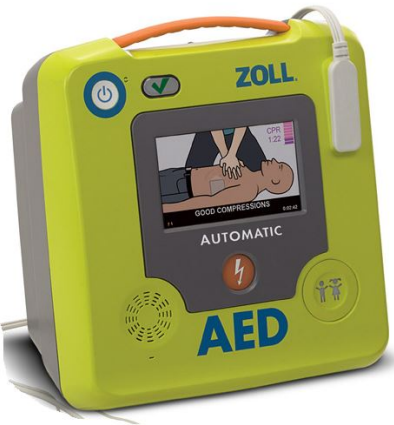


# Fundraising Campaign for Woodheys Park Defibrillator



Local resident Stacey Plews, husband Phil and their 2 children are on a mission to raise £3,000 to buy an AED (Automated External Defibrillator) and pay for its maintenance. It will be installed in a secure cabinet on the outside wall of the Community Building. The defibrillator will be suitable for use on adults and children, giving spoken and on-screen instructions.
